To kick off Flightplan 2008 the Harold Gatty Time Trial competition. I have come up with a course that will challenge you and visually excite you as you fly through some of Tasmania's most beautiful wilderness regions, enjoying catered gourmet Morning Tea at Strahan and a Barbecue Lunch with the Devonport Aero Club.

Everybody has driven past the Harold Gatty Memorial on the Midland Highway, this pays tribute to an outstanding Tasmanian, born in 1903 in Campbell Town. He won fame as an Air Navigator after his record breaking World flight from New York with Wiley Post in the Winnie Mae. He was the pioneer of the Pan American Airways Pacific Air Route and in 1941 founded Fijian Airways. During the second World War he was Director of Air Transport for the allied forces in the Pacific and a group Captain in the RAAF. Our Navigation Time Trials are named in honour of Harold Gatty.

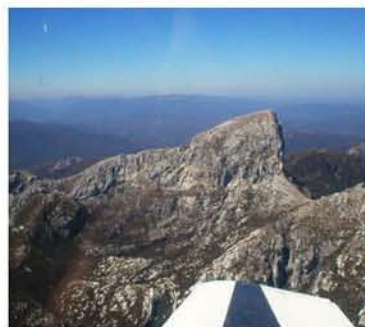
